# **A&SRC Explorers: Spring Break 2024 in Mexico FAQs**

# How much will the program cost?

The program fee is \$425. You will also be charged UTC tuition for 1 credit hour unless you are enrolled in at least 12 other credits for the spring semester.

# What is included in the program fee?

The program fee is all-inclusive. It includes three meals/day, all excursions and activities, international and domestic flights, transportation on-site, transportation to and from the airport, lodging, 24/7 guide. You will only need to have money for your own personal expenses.

### What credit am I going to get?

You will be enrolled in MLNG 2000: Encountering Global Cultures for 1 credit. This credit can be used for general education or elective requirements.

# What will we be doing every day?

Our itinerary is filled with cultural activities and excursions. Each morning will start with breakfast and reflection. We will then hop on our bus and head out into Mexico's rich landscape. We will have plenty of experiential activities and individual free time as well. A tentative itinerary of our time in Mexico is below.

# What happens if I decide not to go?

By applying and accepting your position in this program, you are committing to participating in the study abroad program and the spring course. If you withdraw from the program after the acceptance date of November 15, you may be liable for fees up to the total program fee cost of \$3,500. The study abroad program is an integral part of the MLNG 2000 course; therefore, withdrawing after the beginning of the spring semester is likely to prevent you from receiving a passing grade.

# Do I need to know how to speak Spanish? What if I don't speak any Spanish?

You do not need to know how to speak Spanish to participate in this program! We will be conducting the entirety of the program and course in English with an English-speaking guide. Part of the course curriculum, however, is learning some basic and helpful phrases in Spanish so that you will be able to get around easily and safely.

#### Is Mexico safe?

Safety is UTC's number one priority. As with all study abroad programs, this program will be supported by the UTC Office of Study Abroad and the UTC Safety & Risk Management Team. All participants will be enrolled in comprehensive health and emergency insurance, the US Department of State STEP Program (<a href="https://step.state.gov/">https://step.state.gov/</a>), and UTC's international risk management partner, International SOS

(<a href="https://www.internationalsos.com/">https://www.internationalsos.com/</a>). We will also be with an experienced guide who is trained in health and safety and has worked with US students in Mexico for nearly two decades.

We will be traveling in an area of Mexico that is very safe. Merida, located in the state of Yucatan, is completely approved for travel by the UTC Office of Study Abroad and the US Department of State. Information from the US Department of State regarding travel for US citizens is below:
