- 7) Navigate Demo/Updates- Kaleb demonstrated how students will make appointments. They will need to sign into their student account. Biggest change will be they no longer have an exhaustive list of locations, only the locations where they have an advisor. They will be able to see their assigned team and the availability for appointments by services. Availability links are also now live. Similar screen view for choosing services. Links will not work for students who are not currently active, so re-enrollment campaigns should be run through the campaign function. All availability types will use the same link. Don't use the Forever option when setting availability, since that can cause errors. Add your Zoom link to your availability if you are holding virtual meetings.
