- Outline, in detail, eligibility for grants, including adjuncts, non-tenure track, tenure track, etc.
- Outline procedural guidelines for all of the grant proposals that deals with the process by which a committee member who submits a proposal is included (or not) in the ranking and participation of the round. One suggestion might be that committee members who submit during a particular round are not eligible to read, rate, or vote, on any proposals for that round of proposals.
- Define faculty development and outline grant program using one submission form and process for all faculty development. Consider grouping proposals based on the entire range of faculty development opportunities, including travel, presentations, research, etc.
