This program is designed to be completed in 27 months.

This program will cost approximately \$34,000 for Tennessee students and \$90,000 for out-of-state students if completed within normal time. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

- Anesthesia Board Review Course- \$1,250.00 (Optional)
- BLS, ACLS & PALS Recertification Courses- \$300.00
- Typhon- \$100 (One time cost)
- Apex Anesthesia Review- \$350.00 (One time cost)
- Travel between clinical sites- \$2,300 (across all semesters)
- Hotel for out of town clinical rotation- \$80/per night x 10 nights = \$800
